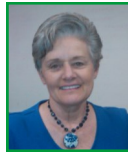

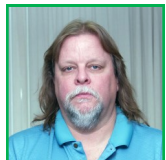
The accomplishment of our task with the memberships' support will greatly insure the improvement of the health and safety of all in the Air Transport Industry in both the U.S. and Canada.

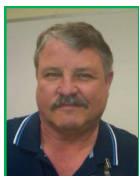
